## T & D Projects Update

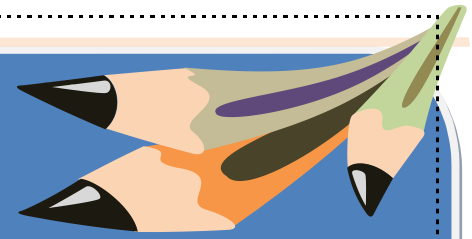
### Mandatory Governance Training

### Elders & Youth Advisory Committee Meeting
